


Parents should not force children to do any work. Just because a child is good at doing homework, a child is good at playing a game, or a child is good at drawing, it is not necessary that everyone does everything

Former Prime Minister Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru was called 'Chacha Nehru', because he was very popular among children. He considered children as the future wealth of the country.





On January 24, 1950, the members of the constitutional assembly signed two copies in Hindi and English. Ambedkar is also commemorated on this day Momentous occasion.


