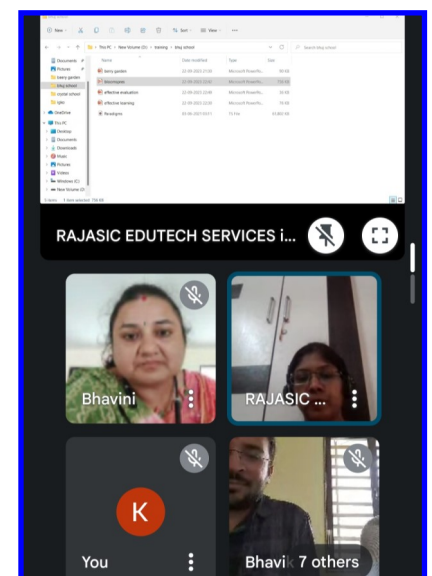
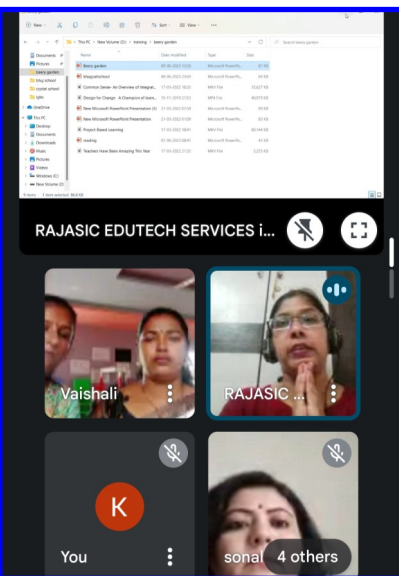
# Teacher's Workshop

Our School also conducted teachers workshop on 23rd September 2023 Saturday S

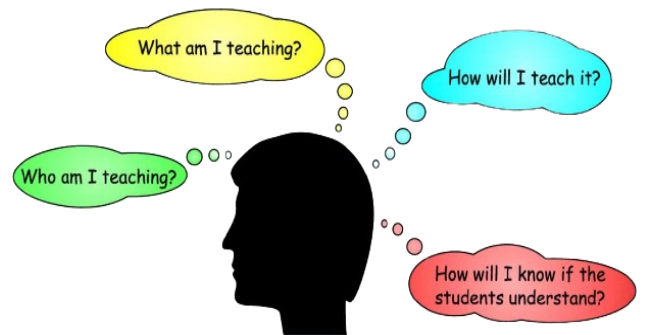
