WHAT EXACTLY IS DIWALI?

Diwali, or the Holiday of Lights, is India's most important festival, celebrated by millions of people. Although Diwali is Hindu festival, it is celebrated by people of all religious. This important Indian festival has various historical and mythical ties.



WHEN DO WE CELEBRATE DIWALI?

People celebrate Diwali, exactly 20 days after the Dussehra festival. In the year 2023, Diwali falls on November 10, 2023 and continues for five days. On each of these days, people observe different festivals, namely, Dhanteras, Naraka Chaturdasi, Lakshmi Puja, Govardhan. Puja, and Bhai Dooj.



WHY DO WE CELEBRATE DIWALI?

Diwali has a deep-rooted significance in both history and mythology. In India, people celebrate Diwali because of the following 12 reasons: 1. After Ravana's defeat, Rama returned to Ayodhya. According to the Hindu epic Ramayana, after conquering the evil king Ravana, Lord Rama, his brother Laxmana, and his wife Sita returned to Ayodhya after 14-years of exile. The people of the kingdom celebrated their return with lights. Thus, earning the name Diwali, "Festival of Lights". 2. The birth of Goddess Lakshmi. 3. Krishna killed the demon Narakasura. 4. Pandava's journey back to Hastinapur. 5. Vishnu saved Lakshmi from King Bali. 6. Coronation of Maharaja Vikramaditya. 7. Bandi Chhor Diwas (Diwali of Sikhs) 8. Mahavira Nirvana Diwas (Nirvana Day). 9. Maharshi Dayananda obtained Nirvana. 10. Kali Puja 11. Diwali as a New Year's Eve 12. End of the harvest season



Another prevalent myth is that Diwali began as a hi festival, commemorating the year's final before winter.

TEACHER'S WORKSHOP

Workshop on NEP & Teacher's Attitude & Aptitude by

22/11/2023

Dr. Rishi Joshi Sir

On this day in Vishnu Dharm School Workshop Program for teachers was held on 22 November 2023, Wednesday between 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM.

During the Workshop Mrs. Hetal Barot, Mr. Hemat Bera, Mrs. Nikhat Menon, Mrs. Sonal Chatterjee and Our guest Dr. Rishi were Present.

All the staff members were excited to gain knowledge about NEP and so Dr Rishi started the program.

The National Education Policy 2023 (NEP 2023) is a document that outlines the vision and goals of the Indian government for the education sector. It was approved by the Cabinet on August 5, 2023, and aims to transform the education system in India by 2030. The NEP 2023 covers various aspects of school education, higher education, teacher education, vocational education, adult education, and digital education. Some of the major highlights of the NEP 2023 are:

- A new 5+3+3+4 structure of school education, which consists of five years of foundational stage, three years of preparatory stage, three years of middle stage, and four years of secondary stage. This replaces the previous 10+2 system and aligns with the cognitive development stages of children.
- A flexible and multidisciplinary approach to higher education, which allows students to choose their subjects and courses across disciplines and exit or re-enter the system at different stages. The NEP 2023 also proposes a four-year undergraduate program with multiple exit options, a single regulator for higher education, and a National Research Foundation to promote research and innovation.
- A comprehensive and holistic teacher education program, which requires all teachers to have a four-year integrated B.Ed degree by 2030. The NEP 2023 also emphasizes the continuous professional development of teachers, the use of technology for teacher training, and the establishment of a National Professional Standards for Teachers.



- A focus on vocational education and skill development, which aims to integrate vocational education with mainstream education from the secondary stage onwards. The NEP 2023 also envisages the creation of a National Skills Qualifications Framework, a National Committee for the Integration of Vocational Education, and a National Institute of Open Schooling for vocational education.
- A commitment to universalize adult education and lifelong learning, which seeks to provide functional literacy and numeracy to all adults by 2030. The NEP 2023 also proposes to expand the scope of adult education to include digital literacy, financial literacy, legal literacy, health literacy, and environmental literacy.
- A vision to leverage digital technology for enhancing access, quality, and equity in education, which includes the development of a National Educational Technology Forum, a National Repository of Educational Resources, and a National Digital Education Architecture. The NEP 2023 also promotes the use of artificial intelligence, big data, cloud computing, and block chain for education.

In the second session he spoke on the topic of Teacher's aptitude and attitude -

Attitude and aptitude are two different concepts. Attitude refers to, as to how we do things, while aptitude indicates the things we are capable of doing. Attitude is the result set of beliefs and emotions, while aptitude is a person's natural ability to learn something. Aptitude is innate and loosely associated with intelligence, while attitude impacts personality and behaviour. Aptitude is something you can learn, but attitude is a lot harder to change and cultivate.

Teaching aptitude is the innate or acquired ability of an individual to teach and facilitate learning in others. It is a combination of various skills, abilities, and qualities that enable an individual to be an effective teacher. Teaching aptitude can be developed through training and education. UGC NET and other teacher eligibility exams test the teaching aptitude of the candidates.

Positive teaching strategies for a happy classroom include:

- Planning lessons around student strengths
- Practicing gratitude
- Teaching forgiveness
- Leading by example
- Making learning relevant
- Creating a classroom code of conduct
- Teaching positive actions
- Instilling intrinsic motivation



Positive behavior strategies are evidence-based, proactive approaches to changing challenging student behavior.

In the end of effective, informative and motivative session we were more energised, all the staff members were clapping with very excitement, all the faces have smiles.

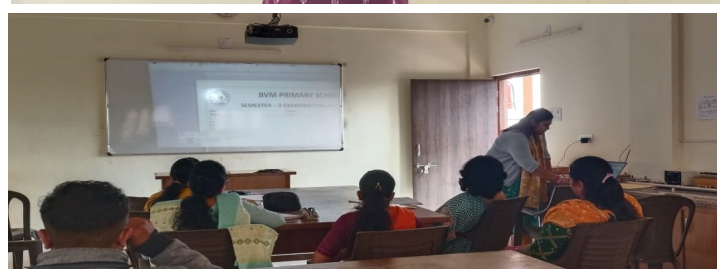
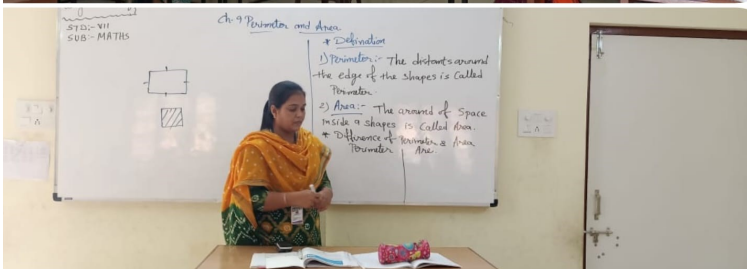
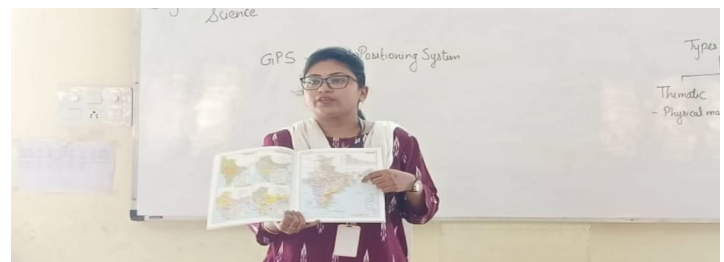
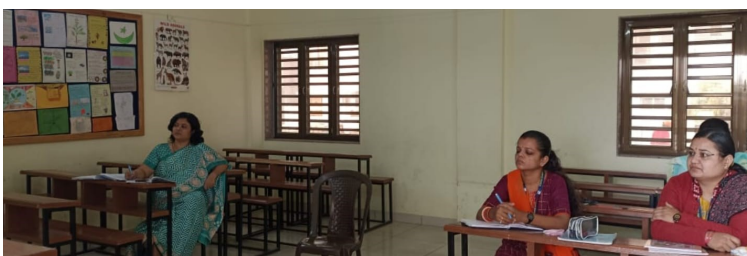
A Vedic Maths training was organized for all teachers by Mr. Jatin Dave. It was fun filled and teachers learned different ways of calculation and enjoyed maths games.

During this times various teachers also conducted their Demo classes as a way of peer teaching-learning. This helped to know and understand different subjects and application of other teacher's teaching methods.

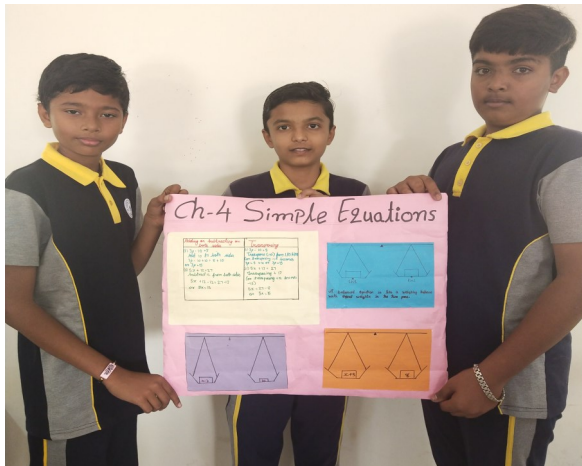
All the teachers also made Teaching Aids to help students understand and learn their subject topics better.

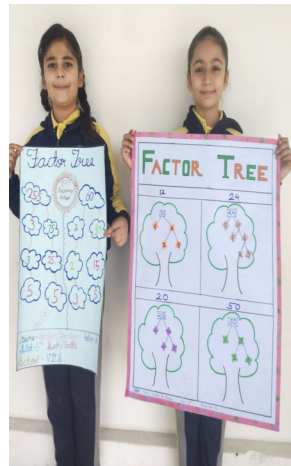

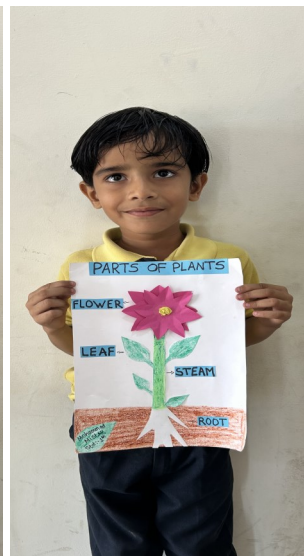
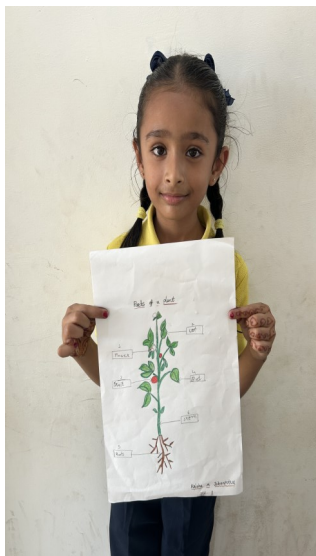
